Up to \$4,500 in Tuition Assistance & Trade Certification Grants

Program Overview

Cook Inlet Tribal Council (CITC) Employment & Training Services provides financial grants for Alaska Native and American Indian individuals seeking vocational credentials, commercial licenses, healthcare certifications, or university coursework.

Eligible Training Tracks & Funding

- **CDL Driving School:** Full or partial tuition match for Class A/B Commercial Driver Licensing.
- **Heavy Machinery & Trades:** Welding, electrical, carpentry, and NCCER certifications.
- **Healthcare & Nursing:** Certified Medical Assistant (CMA), Phlebotomy, and EMT courses.
- **Higher Education:** Degree coursework at University of Alaska or accredited institutions.

How to Apply

1. Contact CITC ETS at (907) 793-3300 or visit Nat'uh Service Center in Anchorage.
2. Submit Tribal Enrollment or Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood (CDIB).
3. Provide acceptance proof from an accredited training facility.
